Please consider joining us between 8 a.m. and 12 p.m. this Saturday, Nov. 13, for a children's COVID-19 vaccination clinic at Adirondack Medical Center in Saranac Lake.

Pfizer-BioNTech pediatric vaccine will be available for all children ages 5-11, with no out-of-pocket costs.

When: Saturday, Nov. 13, 8 a.m.-12p.m.

Where: Annex Building, Adirondack Medical Center, 2233 State Route 86, Saranac Lake, NY 12983

Light refreshments will be provided, but please make sure children eat prior to arrival.

Please also bring your child's health insurance card if they have one. If not, don't worry about it.

No child between the ages of 5 and 11 will be turned away, regardless of school district, county of residence, or insurance status.

The clinic will operate on a first-come-first-served basis, with a required 15-minute observational waiting period after your child's shot.

A second-dose clinic will be held in the same location on Saturday, Dec. 4. Please plan to attend both, so your child is fully vaccinated before the holiday season.

Note: This clinic is for children ages 5-11 only. No adult vaccines or boosters will be available.
