Training the Next Generation of Advanced Practice Clinicians

Hudson Headwaters represents the top 1 percent of all federally qualified health centers in the United States, achieving the best overall clinical performance among the nation's health centers.

The Class of 2022-2023 will begin in September 2022. Application deadline is March 1, 2022.

As Hudson Headwaters transitions to a complete team-based care environment with expanded roles for advanced practice clinicians (APCs), we are committed to creating an APC postgraduate training program designed to increase APC competence and confidence with those skills needed to provide high quality primary care, often to those most adversely affected by the social determinants of health. We strive to provide training to ensure that APCs may function at the highest levels within their scope of practice, while facilitating their growth as leaders within Hudson Headwaters Health Network.

The Advanced Practice Clinician Residency in Integrated Primary Health Care has the following goals:

- To facilitate the gap between an APC's education and real practice.
- To increase confidence and competence among newly trained APCs
- To provide training in team-based health care and to continue to foster interdisciplinary collaboration

Program Description:

- Twelve-month structured training program, running from September 2022 through August 2023.
- Open to both nurse practitioners and physician assistants.
- Two-year commitment to Hudson Headwaters (includes first year of residency and second year of full-time practice).
- Full time salaried position with benefits, paid time off, FSA, and 403B plans.
- Dedicated precepted and mentored clinics, specialty services clinics, and educational sessions.
- Opportunity to participate in research and quality improvement projects.
- Following the first year of residency, APC's will have the opportunity to apply for NHSC loan repayment program, which awards recipients up to \$50,000 for a two-year commitment.
