- Allergic reaction (mild)
- Animal or insect bite
- Asthma symptoms (mild to moderate)
- Burn or rash (minor)
- Cut, scrape or minor wound
- Earache or ear infection
- Fever (in children over 3 months)
- Flu symptoms
- Sore throat, cough or congestion
- Sprain, strain or minor injury
- Stomach pain/diarrhea (mild)
- Suspected fracture (minor)
- ... and other conditions causing mild to moderate pain or discomfort
